From our Pastor's desk....

Dear 'Toti Heaven Train Team',

After spending a while reading and listening to Dr David Jeremiah, I would love to share some of that with you here in our newsletter over the next 3 months (August, September, October).

According to National Geographic, the most mind-boggling thing we can do is gaze into the starry night. On a clear night we might see 3,000 stars with the naked eye, but no one knows how many stars exist. Our universe probably contains more than 100 billion galaxies, and each galaxy may have more than 100 billion stars. What is 100 billion times 100 billion? We don't really have a word for a number that large. We simply say ten billion trillion.

Psalm 8

The Glory of the Lord in Creation. A Psalm of David.

1 O Lord, our Lord, how majestic is Your name in all the earth, Who have set Your glory above the heavens!

2 Out of the mouth of babes and nursing infants You have ordained [established] strength, because of Your enemies, that You may silence the enemy and the avenger. 3 When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, the moon and the stars, which You have ordained [set in place], 4 What is man that You are mindful of him, and the son of man that You visit [care for] him? 5 For You have made him a little lower than the angels, and You have crowned him with glory and honor. 6 You have made him to have dominion over the works of Your hands; You have put

all **things** under his feet, **7** all sheep and oxen— even the beasts of the field, **8** the birds of the air, and the fish of the sea that pass through the paths of the seas. **9** O Lord, our Lord, How excellent [majestic] **is** Your name in all the earth!

The Bible frequently tells us to stargaze. The Lord told Abraham, "Look now toward heaven, and count the stars if you are able to number them" (Genesis 15:5). He told Job, "See the highest stars, how lofty they are!" (Job 22:12) The psalmist praised God when he considered the moon and the stars, which God ordained (Psalm 8:3).

It's harder than ever now to see the stars—we have too much light in our cities. But sometime during this summer, find a dark place, look up, count the stars, and praise the God who created them and who calls each of them by name – "Lift up your eyes on high and see: who created these? He who brings out their host by number, calling them all by name, by the greatness of His might, and because He is strong in power ... not one is missing." (Isaiah 40:26).
